


LE CALENDE

« Terre Del Barolo »

BAROLO



Le Calende's Barolo is an exquisite representation of the Piedmont region and Nebbiolo grape varietal. Defined by a garnet black color, the aromas of berries such as cherries and strawberries open the wine as floral notes and exotic spices balance out the wine. The palate is generous with its structure and silky tannins that are framed by wonderful acidity and minerality. Truly, this wine is nothing short of stunning.

This 100% Nebbiolo Barolo wine comes from 41-year-old vines planted in chalky clay soils around the villages of Barolo, Castiglione Falletto, Cherasco, Diano d'Alba, Grinzane Cavour, La Morra, Monforte d'Alba, Novello, Serralunga, Verduno, and Roddi. The grapes are picked by hand in the vineyard in October, then destemmed and crushed. Fermentation is done at a controlled temperature on the skins for 14 to 16 days, with targeted racking and returning maximizing extraction of flavor, aromas and tannic structure. After complete malolactic fermentation, the wine is then aged for 38 months in French and Slovenian oak barrels.

In Castiglione Falletto, a central winery brings together a small community of vigneroni working and living off the land of the eleven communes that make up the Barolo appellation. These families are joined in their culture and customs to produce an incredible wine from a revered terroir, Barolo. This particular wine showcases an impressive blend of the slight variations in soil structure and micro-climates between the villages.
